

Emergency Paediatric First Aid Qualification (Level 2)

This is a 1-day course which covers a wide range of CPR and First Aid skills relating to children.

Who should attend?

Anyone working with children.

Pre-requisites

Candidates must be at least 16 years of age.

Course contents

- Understanding the role of the paediatric first aider
- How to provide first aid for an infant and a child:
 - who is unresponsive and not breathing normally
 - who is suffering from shock, having an allergic reaction or poisoning
 - who has a foreign body airway obstruction or suffering from asthma
 - who is unresponsive and breathing normally
 - who is injured or bleeding
- How to assess an emergency situation and act safely and effectively

Course duration

6 hours contact time

Assessment

Practical and theoretical assessment on CPR and first aid.

Successful attendees will receive a certificate of competency that is valid for 3 years.
