

Fire Warden / Fire Awareness Training

The aim of the course is to ensure that the Learners not only understand their role but more importantly fully understand the potential dangers that exist in the workplace.

Who should attend?

Members of staff who have been given the responsibility for the maintenance of the general fire precautions requirements for their immediate working environment, on behalf of the employer or landlord and in assisting with clearing the premises during an emergency.

- The common causes of and the prevention of fire
- Good housekeeping
- Maintaining a means of detecting fire and of raising the alarm
- Maintaining a means of escape
- The inspection and safe use of extinguishers
- The actions on discovery of a fire
- The actions on hearing the alarm
- The evacuation process including provision for those needing assistance
- The ideal role of a Fire Marshall/Warden

Assessment

Multiple choice examination. A score of 14 and above out of 20 will qualify candidates as a Fire Warden, otherwise a Fire Awareness Certificate will be issued. Certification is valid for 3 years.
