

Paediatric First Aid Qualification (Level 3)

This course covers a wide range of CPR and First Aid skills relating to children; as well as equipping the first aider to apply first aid to a range of specific injuries and illnesses.

Who should attend?

Those in a supervisory position working with children.

Pre-requisites

Candidates must be at least 16 years of age.

Course contents

- Understanding the role of the paediatric first aider
- How to provide first aid for an infant and a child:
 - who is unresponsive and not breathing normally
 - who is suffering from shock
 - who has a foreign body airway obstruction
 - who is unresponsive and breathing normally
 - who is injured or bleeding
 - with a suspected fracture and a dislocation
 - with a chronic medical condition or sudden illness
 - with burns or scalds
 - with a head, a neck and a back injury
 - who is experiencing the effects of extreme heat and cold
 - who has been poisoned
 - with conditions affecting the eyes, ears and nose
 - who has sustained an electric shock
 - who has been bitten or stung
- How to assess an emergency situation and act safely and effectively

12 hours contact time

Assessment

Practical and theoretical assessment on CPR and first aid.

Successful attendees will receive a certificate of competency that is valid for 3 years.
